As a Youth Mentor you will be trained in proper mentoring methods. We work daily to help our students reach their therapeutic goals and gain greater awareness of their unique abilities to adapt to everyday life.

As a Youth Mentor during the night shift you will be a vital part of a dynamic team whose purpose is to help our students succeed as they strive for the greatest level of autonomy they can achieve. Our night Youth Mentors will be stationed near the students' bedrooms in order to more easily check on them as they sleep to ensure that students are accounted for, safe, and able to get the rest they need. Youth Mentors working the night shift must stay awake throughout the night and perform regular checks on each of the students. Occasionally, specific training will be provided to help in de-escalating a student's emotional state as needed.

Certifications Required:

- First Aid and CPR certificate (Training provided if not currently certified.)
- Food Handler Permit (Online certification course provided if not currently certified.)
- Valid driver's license and safe driving record
- Able to pass background check

Qualifications:

- Applicants should be punctual, and reliable, with consistent and reliable transportation
- Be able to stay awake through the night
- Preference for applicants with experience working in a residential treatment center setting and/or who are currently working towards a Bachelors degree in fields such as Psychology, Social Work, Sociology, Education, or Behavioral Science
